## SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. REGATTA OFFICE, NOTICE BOARD, FLAG POLE LOCATION, SIGNALS & CHANGES TO SIS

- The notice board is at the entry on the east side of the club.
- RRS S3 is replaced with, amendments to the SI made ashore will be posted at least 45 mins before the start of any race affected. Amendments made afloat will be signalled by the display of flag L with 5 sound signals. The Race Committee may communicate these either verbally or in writing.
- When the AP flag is displayed ashore, 60 mins is replaced with 30 mins. This changes RRS S4.2.
- The target is 3 to 5 Races per Day and 11 Races in total.

### 2. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

- Sign on is when a boat crosses the start line
- Sign off is when a boat crosses the finish line for the last race. Should a boat not finish the last race are required to sign off at the club house
- As the transit to the racing areas can be quite far, we will use a buddy system. You must ensure you have a buddy boat before you leave the club, you must keep your buddy informed if you leave early. If your buddy goes missing you are to inform the start boat or the club ashore as soon as possible.

### 3. FIRST WARNING SIGNALS

Friday 26 March	15:00
Saturday 27 and Sunday 28	12:00

### 4. TIME LIMITS

Target Race Time	30 mins
Finishing window	15 mins

Boats not finishing in the finish window may be allocated a score. Changes RRS 35, A4, A5 & S12.3  
No warning signal will be made after 15:30 on the last day of racing.

### 5. CLASS FLAG

Class Flag = 1

## **6. PENALTIES AT THE TIME OF AN INCIDENT**

- For the multihull class(es) rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **7. START SEQUENCE**

Start sequence will be 5 minute sequence

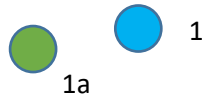
## 8. Course Area

Sunday will be determined on the day – please check the notice board

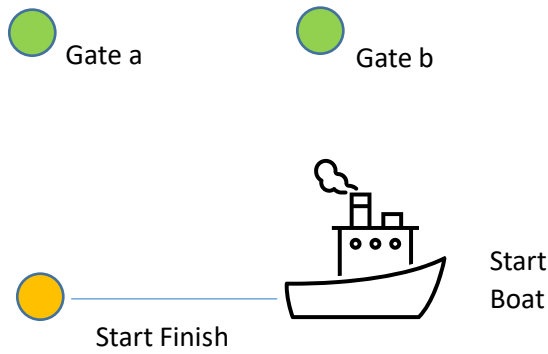
